It has the world-recognized university competitiveness in the QS World University Evaluation, THE Asia University Evaluation, and Leiden Ranking Evaluation, and our university is proud of its lowest tuition and various and abundant scholarship support.

Jeonbuk National University is located in Jeonju, North Jeolla Province. Jeonju City is the most Korean city where the beauty of Korea is alive. Jeonju, which has a brilliant history of being the royal capital of Hubaekje and the root of the Joseon Dynasty, is a cultural city representing East Asia. 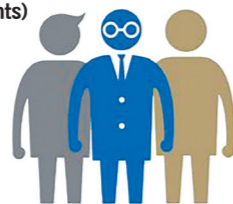

- Korea, a world-class archery powerhouse, how did they shoot arrows in the past? Korean traditional archery learning with traditional Korean archery



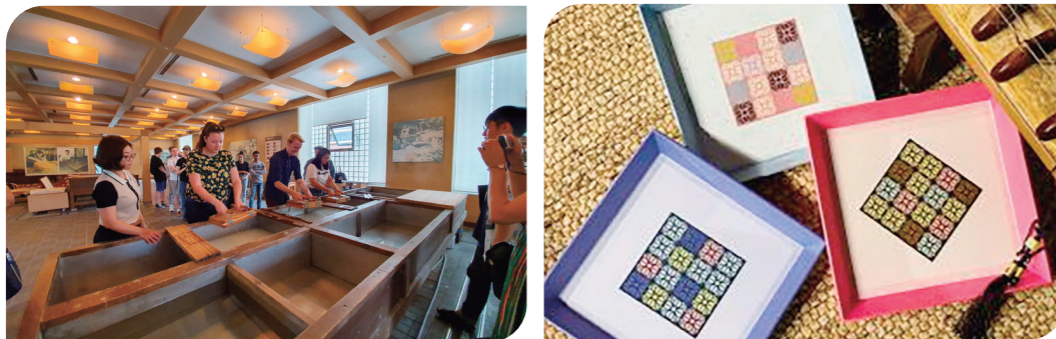
