- Creating hubs for new culture and arts
- Effectively utilizing idle assets

- Insufficient transportation infrastructure
- · Labor shortages
- · Cooperation with government

#### **Perth City**

Fremantle Prison (World Heritage Site)

- The ideal model for night-time tourism

#### **Torchlight Tour**

- · Held only on Wednesdays and Fridays
- · Different from regular tours (includes short skit)
- Visitors receive the torchlight used during the tour as a souvenir
- · Priced higher than regular tours
- Regular Tour: Adults \$24
- Torchlight Tour: Adults \$30
- Providing higher satisfaction
  - Held on specific days of the week
  - → A sustainable operational model
  - Plenty of restaurants nearby
    - → Significantly contributing to night-time consumption



### Analysis of Night-time Events Kagoshima Castle Ruins

**Shochu Night Garden** (2020)

- Held as an alternative event to

Mid-Autumn Festival Banquet (October 26, 2025)

- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Held for the second time due to the last year's popularity.
- Participation fee: ¥23,000
- · Participants: 100 people
- ⇒While satisfaction is high
  - ⇔The scale and content make regular hosting difficult.



#### After participating...

- · Many participants, right up to capacity
- Many locals come to visit
  - ightarrow Expect an increase in night-time spending by locals seeking to enjoy a sense of the extraordinary.

Goal: To help visitors learn the history of Sengan-en through night-time experiences and contribute to the local economy.

### Permanent night-time event

Offering night-time openings and small-group guided tours exclusively on Fridays or Saturdays.



## **Expansion of night-time** consumption

Discount coupons usable at restaurants in the Kagoshima Chuo Station area: Promoting use of public transportation such as the Nippo Main Line.
